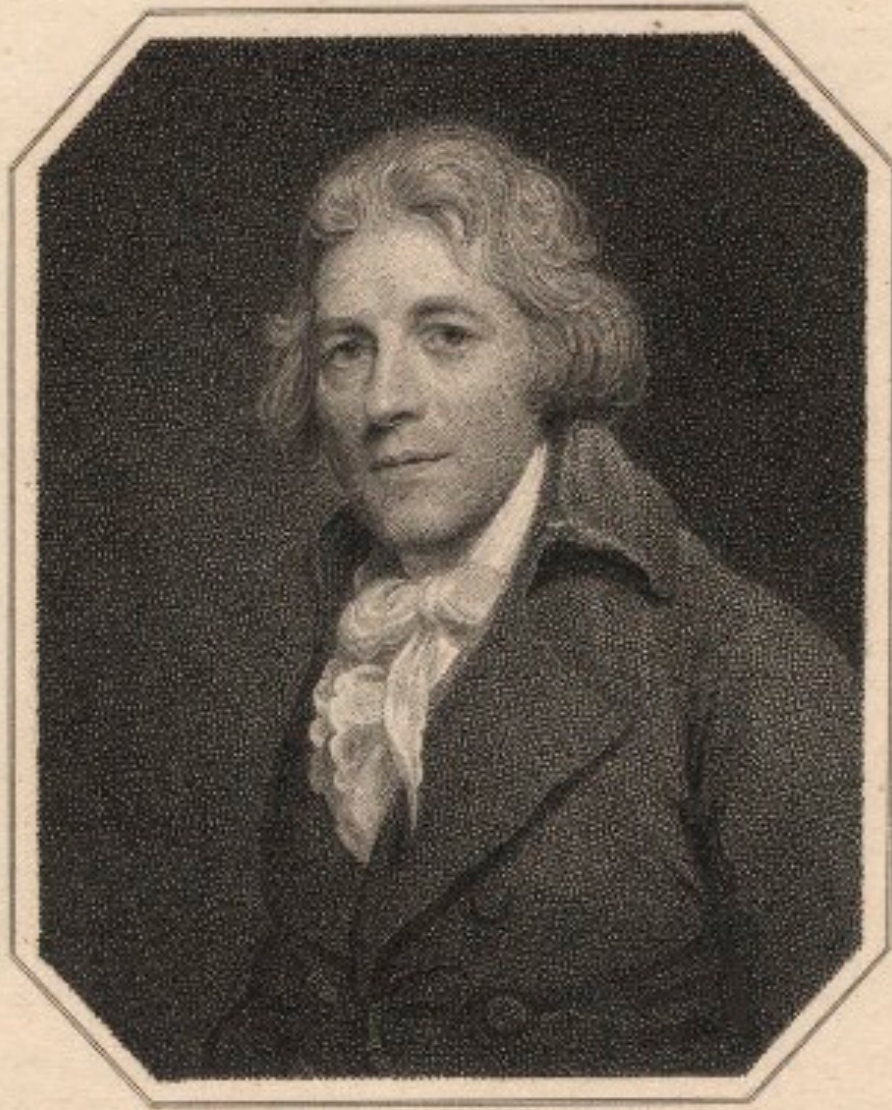

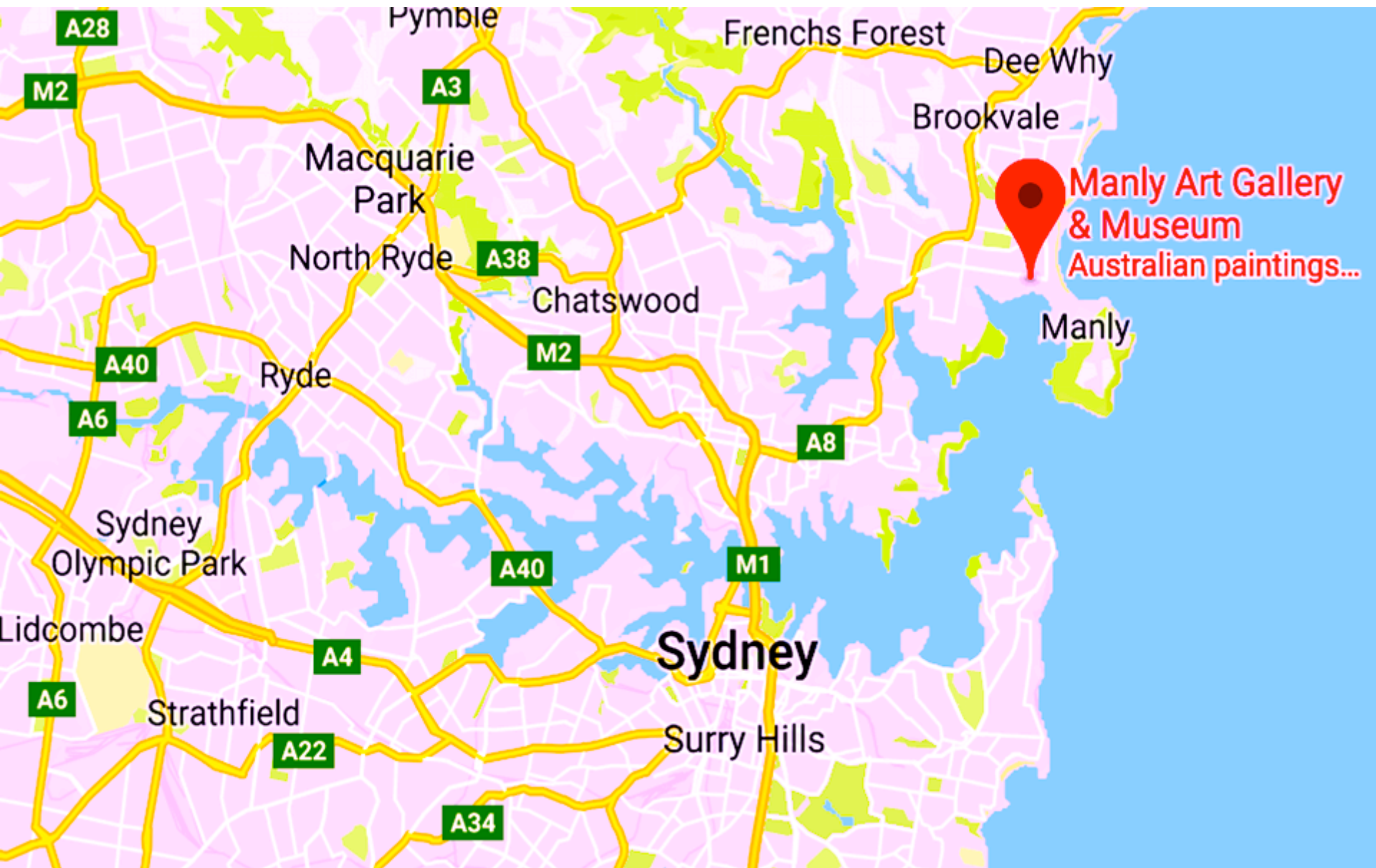

“Entrance of Port Jackson 27 January 1788” **ML**

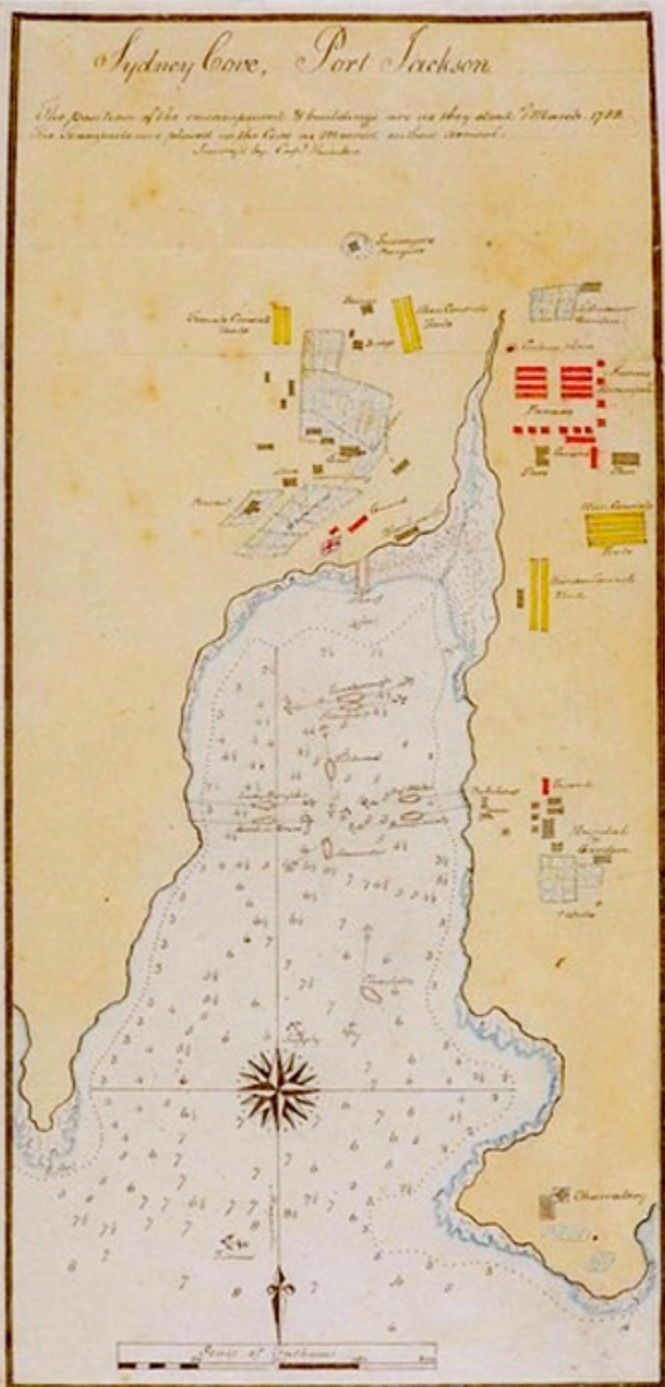


Entrance of Port Jackson 27 January 1788.

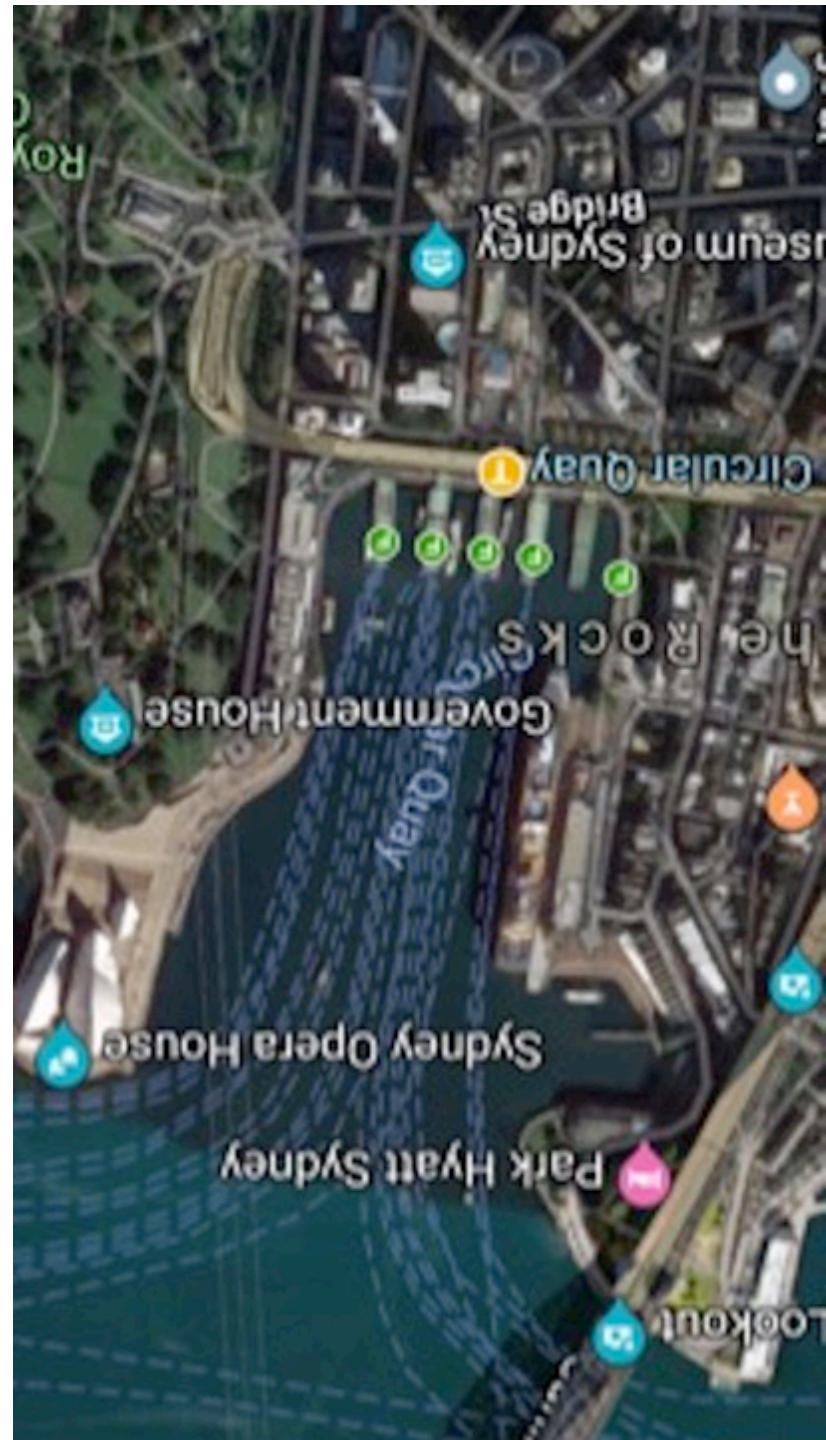

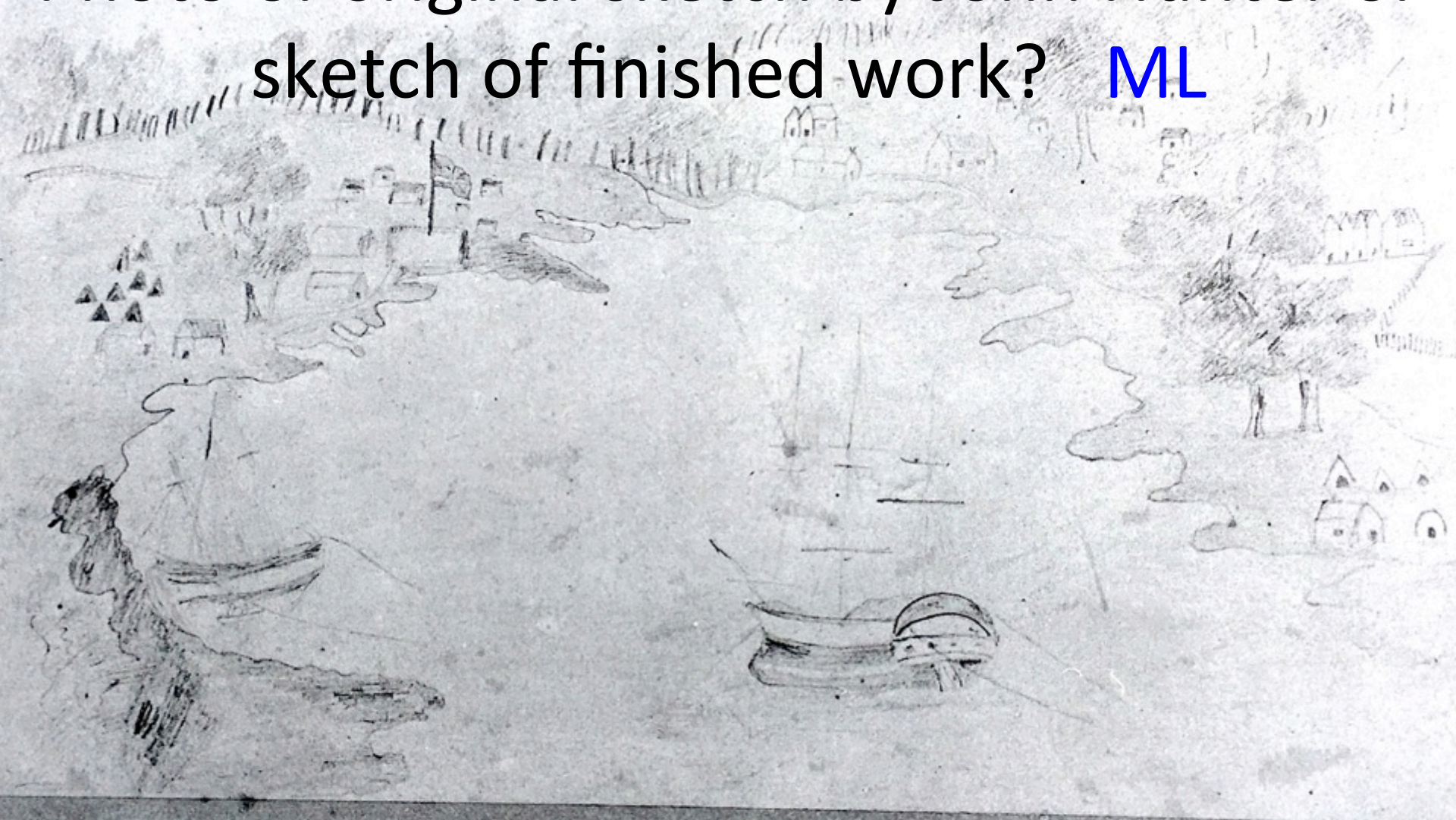

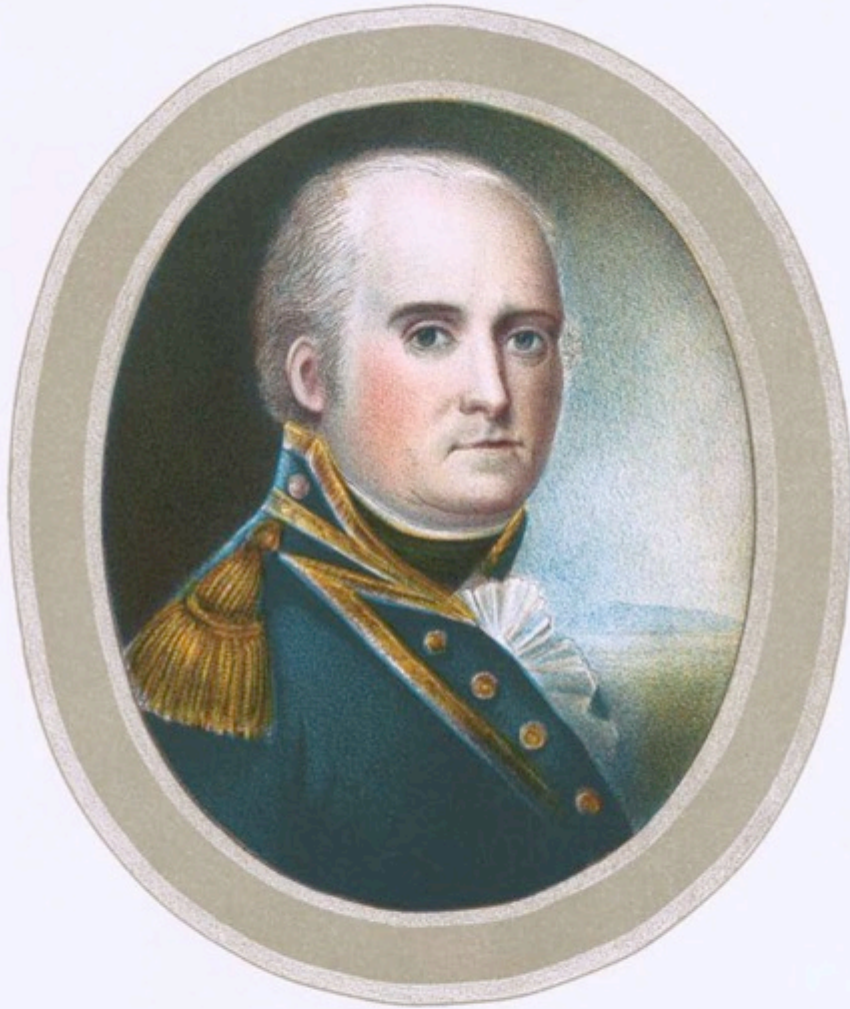

Interesting Fact:

Philip Gidley King married Anna Coombe in London 1791 and they had 4 daughters and one son, Philip Parker King.

His two “natural” sons, by the convict Ann Inett, were born in 1789 and 1790 when King was Lieutenant-Governor of Norfolk Island. They were well cared for by their father and rose to be lieutenants in the navy. They were named ‘Norfolk’ & ‘Sydney’.
